NCC to build Neptunus car park in Linköping

NCC has been commissioned by property company Sankt Kors to build a parking garage in central Linköping. The order is worth around SEK 150 million.

The construction of the new car park is a collaborative project between NCC and property company Sankt Kors. This is the fifth project under the strategic framework agreement signed by the parties and where NCC is carrying out the works on the framework and foundations. NCC has previously constructed new buildings, added floors and renovated existing car parks belonging to Sankt Kors.

“Collaboration with other stakeholders in the field is key to the success of this project. We have a very good track record of working together with Sankt Kors, which we can now continue to build on so as to make things as good as possible for everyone involved,” says Jörgen Kernell, production manager at NCC Infrastructure.

The car park is being built next to Linköping’s new swimming pool and will be the city’s second largest, with around 600 parking spaces on seven levels and a grocery store at the bottom. This is being built in the Folkungavallen area, a central part of Linköping where plans are afoot to build housing, schools and infrastructure.

Characteristic of the construction in this project is the truss beam method that NCC will use. The truss beam method is an all-concrete framework system where a slab cast in situ interacts with prefabricated, prestressed beams.

“The framework system allows for long spans with few columns in order to maximize the surface area. This technology ensures that buildings last a long time and keeps operating costs down. Our construction team in Östergötland has extensive experience and enjoys working with this method,” says Jörgen Kernell.

Work will start in October 2020 and is expected to be completed in fall 2022. The contract is worth around SEK 150 million and will be registered among orders in NCC Infrastructure business area in the fourth quarter 2020.
